Superior's Ultimate Modular Dock (UMD) system is an option that is applicable to situations where a smart appearance, flexibility and a demountable and moveable option is required. This product is manufactured by the rotational moulding of polyethylene and allows the production of modular pieces that are tough, flexible, UV stabilised and do not deteriorate in a marine environment. The modules can withstand heavy conditions and tough treatment and accessories such as hand rails and child safety ladders can be added. A specially

profiled surface ensures slip resistance and the ease with which modules can be connected make this style of pontoon particularly useful for swimming platforms, jet ski docks and residential pontoons.

PONTOONS



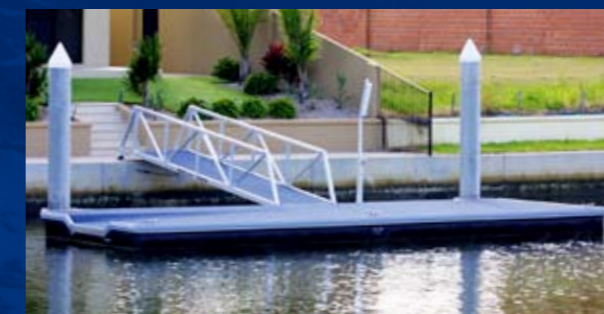
The Elite™ and Silver ranges of concrete floating pontoons are constructed using a solid monolithic flotation system and are functional, durable and aesthetically pleasing. The flotation is protected by a heavy duty sealed polyethylene skin that is UV stabilised, tough, flexible and able to withstand heavy impact. The top of the pontoon is smartly finished with a customised aluminium water and marine carpet. Purpose constructed accessories such as live bait wells, sink stations, lights and chairs, in addition to utility services pedestals, can easily be incorporated.

Pontoons can be secured by a variety of methods to allow for site specific factors and application needs. Piles sunk into the sea bed and securely attached to the pontoon, while still allowing flotation for tide and weather conditions, are often chosen

when maximum security for the berthing of a larger vessel is required.

Strut and gangway securing is an economical alternative for most private leisure craft in moderately calm conditions. Cable attachment is yet another option in situations that are relatively close to shore in sheltered conditions such as canal estates and lakes.

A Dry Berth pontoon is an option for owners of small to medium sized vessels up to 2 tonnes who want to safely dry store a boat at their property on a natural waterway or canal. Utilising a "one size fits all" roller system, an electric winch and a specially shaped pontoon surface, an individual can quickly and simply store their boat on top of the pontoon to allow for easy maintenance and access while minimising the craft's exposure to the effects of constant immersion.
